


Stool sample for parasite tests F-ParaNhO and F-DifrNhO

Pick up the sampling kit from a HUSLAB unit

- A kidney bowl or e.g. a paper plate.
- A sampling stick
- Test tube (eSwab)
- Closable plastic bag and a name label

Taking the stool sample

- 1. Take a sample of stool e.g. on a paper plate.
- 2. Open the pink cap of the sample tube and place the tube upright on an even surface.
- 3. Remove the sampling stick from its package.
- 4. Stick the end of the sampling stick into the stool. A thin layer of stool is enough, avoid excess amounts.

- 5. Insert the sampling stick into the liquid inside the tube and mix well.
- 6. Break the stick off into the tube and close the pink cap carefully.
- 7. Write your name, personal identity code, and sampling date and time on the label.
- 8. Place the sampling tube (pink cap) and the label into the plastic bag. Close the bag carefully.
- 9. Bring the tube to the laboratory preferably during the same day. If you cannot bring the sample during the same day, keep the sample in the fridge until the next day.
